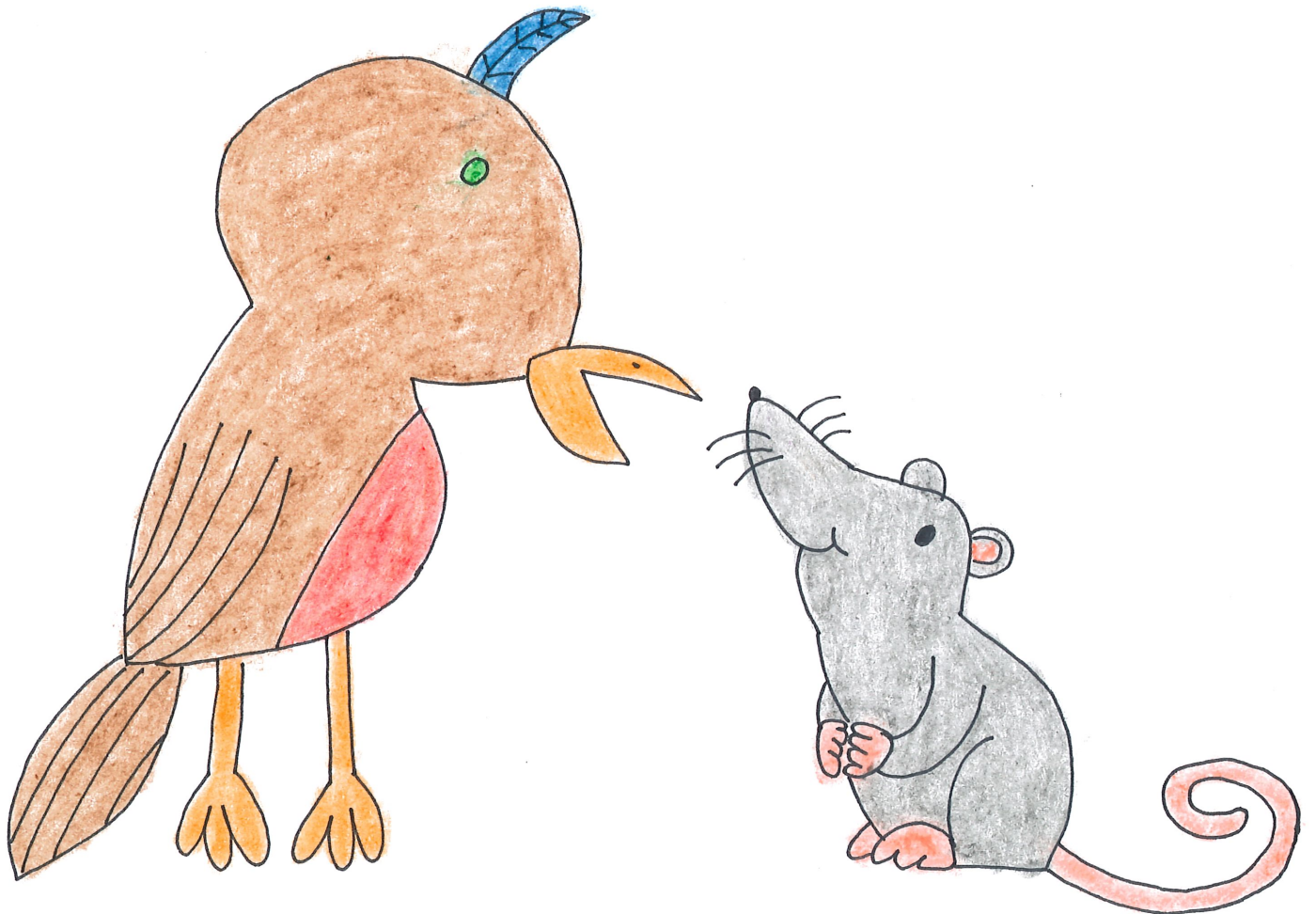


Little Red Robin Hood
